# About the TNUSSP

The Dept. of Municipal Administration and Water Supply, Government of Tamil Nadu Municipal (MAWS, GoTN) aims at scaling up access to safe and sustainable sanitation to all its urban areas in the next five years. Tamil Nadu will be poised to becoming a fully sanitized and healthy state, substantially eliminating open defecation, achieving improvements through the entire sanitation value chain, safely disposing an increasing proportion of its human excreta, and re-using/ recovering resources therefrom. The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation (BMGF) is supporting GoTN to achieve the Sanitation Mission of Tamil Nadu. This support shall enable the GoTN in investing resources towards innovative solutions to achieve mission goals.

A Technical Support Unit (TSU) will be set up to be the comprehensive technical arm for the MAWS-GoTN, and will assist in implementation of state-level and city-level initiatives, based on agreed parameters. In addition, two sub-TSUs will be set up in two select urban locations. IIHS is recruiting specialists for the following components:

## **Job Description**

The Practice Team is responsible for providing cutting-edge and integrated solutions to India's urban development challenges by bringing together faculty and experts across diverse domains of knowledge and practice; exposing learners to real-life problems and integrating the practice into academics and research.

This is a full time position, in the Practice Team at IIHS based out of Chennai. The Senior Specialist Behaviour Change Communication will be responsible for execution of the Behaviour Change and Communication Component. The deliverables for this component include:

- Updation and implementation of the communication strategy and action plans at State and ULB levels
- Preparation of communication materials
- Roll-out of communication campaign in select towns and State level
- Impact Assessments

## **Activities and Tasks**

Your responsibilities would include, but not be limited to, the following -

- Carrying out activities for preparing, updating and implementing the Behaviour Change and Communication component activities of the TNUSSP;
- Anchoring the preparation of a comprehensive multi-media communication plans targeted to multiple segments (including but not restricted to different socio-economic groups, public sector, private sector, and other segments);
- Contributing to the design, data collection and analysis of baseline studies to elicit data for developing and refining communication strategies (including but not restricted to segmentation, consumer awareness and preferences, psychographics, positioning and promotional strategies, etc.);
- Facilitating and guiding the preparation of various communication materials, in multiple languages especially in English and Tamil;
- Helping the State and ULBs, and other stakeholders, develop and implement strategies and action plans using multiple media, including community-based promotion;
- Providing Facilitation and handholding support for communication campaign roll out at the state and ULB levels;
- Designing and implementation Impact Assessment Studies for communication strategies and action plans (including but not restricted to campaigns);
- Interfacing and engaging with Govt. of Tamil Nadu, clients, partners, communities, institutions, and other stakeholders for TNUSSP;

- Teaching and/or assisting in teaching relevant courses in IIHS' Academic and Executive Education Programmes as needed;
- Providing support to other IIHS activities including academics, research, operations and other activities;
- Participating in all activities of Institution-building at IIHS; carrying out tasks as assigned by IIHS; and travelling on IIHS work within or outside the country as needed.

## **Structure and Reporting**

The Senior Specialist: Behaviour Change Communication will report to the Team Leader, TNUSSP. The TNUSSP Team reports to the Chief - Practice, IIHS.

## **Person Specification**

The candidate is required to possess training and experience in Communications, Media or Social Sciences/Development studies, and 10-15 years of experience. The candidate should have a demonstrable track record of having developed and facilitated communication campaigns especially in the social/development sector. Preference will be given to candidates familiar with behaviour change.

She or he should also have experience of working in multi-disciplinary teams, good people management skills, and significant competency in project management, IT and social media skills. Candidates should also have prior experience of working with government. Preference will be given to candidates with Tamil language skills, and work experience in Tamil Nadu.

#### Location

The position is based in Chennai, with frequent travelling to other locations in Tamil Nadu.

The role and performance of the candidate shall be subject to normal review and assessment systems at IIHS.
