Job Description

The IIHS UPP is looking to hire/contract an expert and trainer in the field of urban social sciences specializing in one or more of the following: housing (affordable housing and slums), urban poverty issues and urban livelihoods, and related financial and institutional questions and approaches.

As consultant in the UPP team, the applicant will be responsible for developing training content, will lead in the delivery and coordination of training programmes, and be responsible for completing reporting and monitoring requirements. Additionally, the consultant will contribute to primary and secondary research of thematic and general interest to the UPP team. The UPP's teaching and training programme spans across the country and the consultant will be expected to travel accordingly.

The consultant will also contribute to UPP development work such as proposal development, impact assessment, translations, workshops, training of trainers, and other such activities.

Structure and Reporting

The Consultant – Urban Practitioners' Programme will report to the Lead – UPP at IIHS and collaborate effectively with a diverse group of internal teams and external faculty/organizations, and students.

Person Specification

The applicant should have about 10 years of relevant professional experience. She/he should have relevant educational qualifications in the identified themes of urban social science, housing, poverty or livelihoods, and must be familiar with the empirical and scholarly work around these themes. Additionally, the applicant will need to be familiar with the policy level and programmatic approaches to these themes at the Central and State levels. Experience and exposure to projects in these thematic areas will be given additional weight in the selection. An ability to train and teach in these themes is a must.

The UPP welcomes applicants from research, academic, social and practice fields. Applicants must be willing to travel as per programme requirements.

Location

This position is based in Bengaluru and may entail travel to other locations in India.
