The TNUSSP was launched in November 2015, as the Techncial Support Unit (TSU) for the Government of Tamil Nadu (GoTN) to make improvements in fecal sludge and septage management (FSSM) along the full cycle of sanitation (FCS) across Tamil Nadu. A consortium of organisations, the programme is led by the Indian Institute for Human Settlements (IIHS) to make clean water and sanitation accessible.

Job Description

The communications specialist will be a part of the TNUSSP core team, responsible for supporting the planning and delivery of project and programme-level communications and public engagement. The incumbent will be actively involved in setting the direction and implementation of the outreach and public engagement strategy of the TNUSSP projects, with a focus on knowledge dissemination and branding.

S/he will work closely with the TNUSSP staff on programme/ project and external communications. The role will also require working in close coordination with the IIHS Communications & Design team to ensure that project and programme communications are harmonised with the core communication strategy and design at the institutional level.

This is a contractual position for an initial term of 11 months, renewable on mutual consent, with the potential to turn into a regular position over time.

Activities and Tasks

Responsibilities would include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Supporting the Communications team in the strategising, planning, development and implementation of the communications and outreach work of TNUSSP;
- Helping develop, produce and disseminate content to engage and educate audiences across various channels via. newsletters, blogs, graphics, website content, and social media posts, with particular emphasis on knowledge products/ collaterals, based on institutional priorities;
- Helping drive online and onsite events and campaign rollouts internal and external;

- Assisting in business development efforts, including pitch notes and presentations, as and when relevant;
- Providing support to other IIHS activities including academics, research, training, practice, operations and others, including contributions to keeping the IIHS and TNUSSP websites up to date;
- Participating in all activities of institution-building at IIHS; carrying out tasks as assigned by IIHS; and travelling on IIHS work within or outside the country as and when needed.

Structure and Reporting

The communications specialist will be an External Consultant coordinating with the Communications Manager – TNUSSP & CWIS, or with any other person designated by the Team Leader – TNUSSP; and will be required to collaborate effectively with a diverse group of internal teams and external individuals/organizations, and students.

Person Specification

The ideal candidate should have:

- A Bachelor's or Master's degree in Journalism, Communications, Marketing or similar discipline;
- 2 5 years of experience in external communications, journalism, public relations, or content creation for development organisations, corporates, or educational institutions;
- Experience in communications research and strategy, media relations, developing content for various audiences, digital engagement best practices, network management, and event planning and management would also be highly desirable;
- Sound writing skills; the ability to juggle between short and long forms of writing for diverse audiences and media;
- Basic design skills; working knowledge of Canva and Adobe Express;
- Basic understanding of CRM and contact database management on platforms like Brevo;
- Team working skills; the ability to multitask and meet deadlines;
- Effective communication skills in English, both oral and written; fluency in Tamil would be an added advantage.

This is a contractual position for an initial term of 11 months, renewable on mutual consent, with the potential to turn into a regular position over time. This offer is on an exclusive basis, which implies that other professional assignments (whether compensated or not) that bear a potential conflict of interest with IIHS cannot be undertaken.

Location

This position is based in Chennai and may entail travel to other locations in India.


