The Campus Development team focuses on design, procurement, execution, and documentation activities at the IIHS Kengeri site. The work includes supporting Building Information Modelling (BIM) using the Revit and Grasshopper platforms for Campus site infrastructure and buildings, 3d modelling using the Rhino and SketchUp platforms, data analysis for sustainability parameters and coordination with various stakeholders involved in the project.

Job Description

IIHS is looking to hire an architect with around 4 to 6 years of work experience. This position will be part of the Campus Development team at IIHS based out of Kengeri, Bengaluru. The responsibilities for this role will involve supporting campus development activities, including but not restricted to converting existing infrastructure and building drawings to BIM using the Revit and Grasshopper platforms, 3d modelling using the Rhino and SketchUp platforms, data analysis for sustainability parameters and coordination with various stakeholders involved in the project. The work will also involve direct architectural intervention as per regular business

practices, as well as research, publications, prototyping and creation of policies, standards and guidelines.

This could be either a regular position or a 11- month contractual engagement, renewable on mutual consent, with the potential to turn into a regular position over time.

Activities and Tasks

Responsibilities would include, but not be limited to, the following:

- BIM modelling in the Revit platform and 3d models in the Rhino platform for existing/ proposed campus infrastructure and buildings;
- Visiting sites for primary data collection, including spatial, quantitative, and qualitative data;
- Coordinating with design and execution teams for proposed and ongoing activities at the site to ensure that deadlines, procedures, and other project requirements are met;
- Assisting in the preparation of teaching-learning material and training activity related to use of the Revit and Rhino platforms;
- Organising workshops and consultations with key stakeholders;
- Additionally, the incumbent is expected to be involved in the full range of activities at IIHS: the candidate will thus also be expected to be part of IIHS' teaching programmes, its public conferences and conventions, and its capacity building programmes through executive education and short courses;
- Providing support to other IIHS activities including academics, research, training, practice, operations and others;
- Participating in all activities of Institution-Building at IIHS; carrying out tasks as assigned by IIHS; and traveling on IIHS work within or outside the country as and when needed.

Structure and Reporting

The BIM modelling and 3D visualizing expert will be an External Consultant coordinating with the Lead - Campus Development at IIHS and will be required to collaborate effectively with a diverse group of internal teams and external individuals/ organisations, and students.

Person Specification

The ideal candidate should have:

- A professional degree in Architecture and/or a Master's in Architecture / Planning;
- 4-6 years of prior experience, preferably in the design and execution of sustainable buildings;
- Prior experience working on the Revit and Rhino platforms in addition to AutoCAD,
 SketchUp, InDesign and Photoshop;
- Demonstrable knowledge of sustainable building practices and methods, embodied energy analysis and life cycle analysis;
- An understanding of building codes, environmental regulations, and green building rating systems;
- The willingness to travel from time to time as per project requirements;
- Effective verbal and written communication skills;

- Flexibility and the ability to work well in a fast-paced environment;
- Competence in handling simultaneously occurring tasks and smaller projects;
- Excellent organisational skills and effective team working skills;
- Software & Skills
 - Revit, Rhino, Grasshopper, AutoCAD, SketchUp, Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign;
 - o MS office;
 - o Model making;
 - o 3ds Max (optional).
